Dear Church Family,

Many persons have had a profound effect on my spiritual journey from 1975 until now. Some of these persons are still among us and others have gone on to receive their eternal reward. One of those persons was Dr. Gilbert W. Stafford, one of many past Church of God leaders, seminary professors and advisors who helped frame my understanding of what Jesus would require of me. A reference from his book, *Church of God At the Crossroads*, offers a prayerful invitation as we prepare to celebrate the High Holy Week of Passion concluded by Easter Sunday, April 24th. Dr. Stafford writes about the founder of the Church of God Movement, A passage of Scripture often at the center of the movement was I Thessalonians 5:23, *May the God of peace himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be kept sound and blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.* Dr. Stafford goes on to explain this more by pointing out that the words "entirely, completely, wholly" or the phrase "through and through" is referenced only in this passage in the New Testament by two Greek words.

Those two Greek words: "holos" meaning whole and "telos" meaning goal. Thus, this prayer in I Thessalonians is for God to cleanse us and set us apart for divine service in such a way that **everything** about us will serve the goal that God has for us personally and for the church.

This month finds us at the crossroads of being cleansed and set apart for God's use. God accomplishing His desires through us, has kingdom significance. It will take our total commitment and the love of God declared in John 3:16. "Our commitment" and "His Love" intersect at a crossroad on our spiritual journey. I desire to witness, at Kendall, this Easter Season the prayer of I Thessalonians 5:23, "May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through [entirely]; May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."
