"Giving Thanks by Giving"

"In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus said: It is more blessed to give than to receive."

Acts 20:35

Dear Church Family,

This is the month that many persons across our nation will prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving. No doubt because of the state of the economic crisis with joblessness having an impact on 10% of all Americans and the depressing news of foreclosure of homes for millions of families, the question can be asked by many, "How can we give thanks."

The Apostle Paul in the above passage shared a very personal feeling and moment of encouragement as he was traveling through Macedonia and Greece. He was impressed by the giving spirit of the Macedonia Christians. For the Macedonian Christians, their giving was not a chore but a challenge, not a burden but a blessing. Giving was not something to be avoided, but a privilege to be desired. They made it their commitment to be "stewards of giving" no matter how little they had. These committed Christians strived to give out of their lack of, rather than their abundance for. This was a Kingdom principle that Jesus introduced, when He told the rich young ruler, "if you want to be perfect, go sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in Heaven..." Paul further illustrates this Kingdom principle about the Macedonia Christians in II Corinthians 7:5-7 when Titus visited them and they gave comfort to him not out of their abundance, but out of their joy of heart to give.

This is a Kingdom understanding of stewardship and the principle of God's economic plan for "sowing and reaping." When we the people of God demonstrate what Jesus declared, we will reap of the harvest from our giving not out of what we have in abundance, but rather what we lack so that we might gain.

I submit to you this month of November as we approach the Thanksgiving Holiday that I will be teaching and preaching on, "Giving Thanks by Giving." You will receive an important Workbook, which will help us to understand "The Seven Spiritual Principles." This workbook along with teaching and preaching from it will be a spiritual benefit to you as a Christian for the sowing and reaping Kingdom principle and all who are in need. The Macedonia Christians sought these stewardship principles and practices as their commitment to their ministry. They demonstrated, "Giving Thanks by Giving."
